### COUNSELING SERVICES

We provide counseling for individuals, marriages, premarital couples, families and children. We also do diagnostic testing, premarital and marital assessments and personnel screening for ministry positions. Our fees are based on a sliding scale and vary according to income level. We offer church assisted counseling for clients who cannot financially afford services.

Our professional counseling staff is made up of men and women who have at least a master's level degree in a counseling-related field and who have a license in counseling, psychology or who are certified social workers in the State of Michigan. The counseling staff works as a team to provide the highest quality services within the context of a caring Christian relationship. They are all dedicated Christian professionals who are supervised by our Director of Clinical Services, Dr. Sam Cherian a fully licensed psychologist who holds a doctorate degree in psychology.

## OUR SERVICES

### ADOPTION SERVICES

Our goal is to ensure the best possible arrangement for both the child and the new parents, and to secure the legal transfer of parental rights and responsibilities from the birth parents to the adoptive parents. We place children in Christian homes where they will have the opportunity to begin a relationship with Christ, and be raised in a stable and nurturing environment. Our vision is to provide positive alternatives to abortion and teen parenting and be an advocate for women who might be considering an adoption plan for their child.

### UNPLANNED PREGNANCY SERVICES

We specialize in helping women of all ages who are pregnant and who might be considering an adoption plan for their child. In an effort to provide positive alternatives to abortion or teen parenting, we provide free counseling prenatal care, adoption planning and foster care. Financial assistance is also available toward labor and delivery costs, as well as court representation related to adoption. There are no fees associated for the services we offer women who are pregnant, the birth fathers, and their families.

### HOMESTUDIES SERVICES

The State of Michigan requires that any prospective adoptive family have a home study performed and documented that assures the court that the family is able and willing to care for any adoptive child. The information that we gather for the home study is mandated by law, and is performed by a licensed social worker.
